**Easter Triduum:** Triduum is the Latin word for 'three days'. These 3 days commemorate the passion, death and resurrection of Jesus and are the most important days in the Christian calendar. The Triduum begins in the evening with the celebration of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday. On Good Friday we focus our hearts and minds on the cross as we recall the death of Jesus. The main liturgy on this day is the Celebration of the Lord's Passion. This day is the only day in the liturgical calendar on which Mass is not celebrated in the Roman Rite. Behold this is the day on which we adore the cross of Christ in a special way. At the end of Holy Saturday around dusk, the Easter Vigil is celebrated. The night was described by St. Augustine as '**the mother of all vigils**'. In its content, this night is the commemoration of the Exodus of the Old Testament people, as well as of the death and resurrection of the Lord. The Easter Triduum ends with evening prayer on Easter Sunday and the fifty day Season of Easter begins until the Feast of Pentecost – Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> May. **'Indeed, I promise you, today you will be with me paradise.'**
