**Feast of St. Columba – 9<sup>th</sup> June:** Next Sunday is the Feast of St. Columba secondary patron of the Diocese of Derry. (Principal Patron – St Eugene) Columba was born to Fedlimid and Eithne of the Cenel Conaill in Gartan, near Lough Gartan, in County Donegal, part of the Province of Ulster in the north of Ireland. He became a monk and eventually ordained a priest. During this time he is said to have founded a number of monasteries, including ones at Long Tower in Derry, Kells, Swords and Iona on the Scottish west coast. Next weekend as part of the City of Culture celebrations there is a festival in Derry celebrating the influence of St. Columba in Derry and its surrounding environments.
