Sports Meeting

Season of Ordinary Time: Ordinary Time, meaning ordered or numbered time, is celebrated in two segments: from the Monday following the Baptism of Our Lord up to Ash Wednesday; and from Pentecost Monday to the First Sunday of Advent. This makes it the largest season of the Liturgical Year. The liturgical vestments are green, and represent the colour of hope and growth; the Church counts the thirty-three or thirty-four Sundays of Ordinary Time, inviting her children to meditate upon the whole mystery of Christ – his life, miracles and teachings – in the light of his Resurrection. If the faithful are to mature in the spiritual life and increase in faith, they must descend the great mountain peaks of Easter and Christmas in order to "pasture" in the vast verdant meadows of *tempus per annum*, or Ordinary Time. **The cycle of Ordinary Time this year is Cycle C – Mark's Gospel.**

The weekday element of this second segment has already begun after Pentecost Sunday and from next weekend the Sunday's will now compliment the weekdays – now that the previous three Sunday's (Feasts of the Lord) have now been completed – (Pentecost, Holy Trinity and Body and Blood of Christ). This period of Ordinary Time now runs until the evening of the 30th November.
