Mission Sunday: In this Mission month of October let us remember and pray for the approximately 1,500 Irish born missionaries who today continue to proclaim the Good News in eighty different countries throughout the world. They follow in the footsteps of thousands of the sons and daughters of this land who have left all for the sake of the Gospel. 'I would like to encourage everyone to be bearers of the Good News of Christ and I am grateful especially to missionaries, men and women religious and lay who by accepting the Lord's call, leave their homeland to serve the Gospel in different lands and cultures' (Pope Francis – Message for Mission Sunday 2013).

When Mission Sunday was instituted in 1926 by Pope Pius XI and it was celebrated in every church and every place, even the poorest on the second last Sunday of October every year. It was the vision of a young French woman, Pauline Marie Jaricot who founded the Association for the Propaganda of the Faith in Lyon after the French Revolution to support the foreign missions. It was then established in its own right as a Pontifical Society in 1922. More than €2 million was donated by the Irish public to the collection last year. As many as 1100 mission dioceses receive funds to assist projects. These would include providing the bare essentials of life for missionaries, formation of the laity and catechists: building churches, community and pastoral centres; and supporting the invaluable work of catechists. 25% of the Mission Sunday collection is given to the Society of St. Peter Apostle to support the formation and education of priests, brothers and sisters. Last year this Diocese of Derry was the second largest contributor in the country to this collection and we thank you once again for your generous support.
