Plenary Indulgence for the Holy Souls: Is available for the first eight days of November. From November 2nd the Feast of All Souls we remember all the dead in our prayers. The plenary indulgence is gained by visiting a cemetery and the reception of the Sacraments of Reconciliation and the Eucharist.

Annual Parish Mass for the Dead: Next Saturday 2nd November (All Souls) at 6pm in St. Patrick's Church, Aughaclay – Vigil Mass. This is a parish occasion hence it is important we gather in one church annually to remember our dead. The names of the dead of the parish will be displayed in each of the three churches during November and will remain there for the duration of the month. Included in the Con-celebrated Mass will be a Service of Light (candle ceremony) in which a member of the deceased family is invited to light a candle during the service. We request those who have experienced the death of a loved

one since the beginning of November last year to identify a member of their family who will participate in this ceremony. (Candles will be provided). They are asked to make themselves known in the sacristy before the Mass begins, and also to collect the candle in the sacristy to take home after the Mass.
