Malin Parish Revenue Charitable Donations Scheme: This year changes were announced in the Budget which makes the administration of this scheme much easier. Both PAYE and self-employed persons now complete the same form and the refund will be at the one rate of 31%. A new enduring declaration of the total donated to the parish each year will be valid for 5 years. It is very important that all parishioners who pay tax are part of this scheme and enable some of your tax to be returned as a further donation to the parish. It does not affect your tax liabilities. The form to be filled in is available at the back of the church and in the sacristy or from any of the priests. please make sure you include your phone number on this form. This is an excellent way to continue to support your parish. Your co-operation is greatly appreciated.
