Confirmation: Photography Guidelines on Use of Photography and video at Malin Confirmation. The use of photography and video is an issue of great concern among those working with children. The Diocese recognises that every parish has their own arrangements in relation to its use for the sacraments. The parish of Malin has arranged for a professional photographer to take photographs of each child with the parents' permission during the

ceremony and in the parish hall. This means that parents or relatives should NOT be taking photographs or video DURING the celebration of Confirmation. The professional photographer will take school group pictures immediately after the ceremony in the church and before moving to the parish hall. It would be greatly appreciated if parents and relatives would co-operate with these guidelines.
