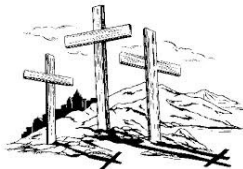

Good Friday: Is a day of fast and abstinence. There is an obligation to fast, (one main meal and two light meals in the course of the day and to abstain from meat). The law of fasting applies to all Catholics from 18-59 years of age (except those who are sick). The law of abstinence applies to all Catholics over the age of 14 years.

Trocaire Boxes: Please return to the churches in the parish during any of the services during the Triduum – Holy Thursday, Good Friday or over the Easter weekend.
