This course is offered to men and women from all walks of life who have completed the Pathways course or its equivalent or who are involved in some form of prayer guidance or Scripture study. It is possible to do the course for validation by St. Mary's University College or for personal development alone. This two-year programme runs from October to June each year and will be held on seven Saturdays from 10am - 4:30pm at Drumalis.
