Cursillo 30th Anniversary Renewal Weekend: This year, 2015, is the 30th Anniversary of the founding of the Cursillo movement in the Diocese of Derry. To mark this occasion the Derry Diocesan Secretariat are holding a special Renewal weekend at Termonbacca Carmelite Retreat Centre. The weekend begins on Thursday evening 24th September with a thanksgiving Mass, in St Eugene's Cathedral, for the gift of Cursillo to the Derry diocese. This will be celebrated by Bishop Donal Mc Keown during which he will deliver a key note address on the missionary role of the laity. Anyone who has done a Cursillo is invited to attend.
