Parish Prayer Day for Marriage and Family Life. This Monday it is our turn once again as a parish to pray for the 24 hours. This is part of a Movement of Continuous Prayer for Marriage & Family Life as other parishes and groups take on the prayer for the other days of the month. To make this prayer continuous, many people in our parish have committed themselves to a specific hour of prayer on Monday 20th in such a way that the whole day and night are covered. Everyone is invited to join in this prayer, either by taking on an hour, or by including this intention in your own prayer during that day; by including it in the prayers of the Masses celebrated on that day; by inviting the schools of the parish to involve the children and young people in praying for it; by asking any prayer groups that are meeting on that day to also include a prayer for it. During November our proposed theme is remembering our beloved dead. Quote from The Joy of Love: Pope Francis *I can understand the anguish felt by those who have lost a much-loved person, a spouse with whom they have shared so much. Jesus himself was deeply moved and began to weep at the death of his friend (Lazarus). (254)* Some Thoughts: On the 2nd of November our parish celebrated a special Mass for loved ones who have died. Families were encouraged to draw up a list while talking together about the various people they were naming. These lists were then placed in the baskets available in our three churches and are prayed for in the Masses throughout the month. To extend on this idea, why not look at the possibility of creating a sacred space somewhere in your home. In this space make a collage of all the Memoriam cards you have of your family and friends. If possible visit the cemetery together as a family and spend some time together at each grave, sharing your memories about each person. These memories are essential because so much of what we are and have has come from these people whom we love and who love us.
