**Parish Prayer Day for Marriage and Family Life** Monday 20<sup>th</sup> August. As you know, the World Meeting of Families is taking place next week. Our prayer day after day before during and after it will be a significant contribution to what it is about and can bring great blessings on those days during which Pope Francis will be in Ireland to encourage us all to make Marriage and Family Life priorities in building up the life of the Church. From midnight this Sunday to midnight on Monday (20<sup>th</sup> we continue praying for the 24 hours with our monthly prayer day. This month may we remember especially the Vocation of the Single Person. Everyone is invited to join in this prayer, either by taking on an hour, or by including this intention in your own prayer during that day. While many people in our parish have committed themselves to a specific hour of prayer in such a way that the whole day and night are covered, new people are welcome to join at any stage. We generally think about vocation in terms of priesthood and religious life – and sometimes in terms of marriage. Very seldom do we consider the vocation of the single person. For us as Christians there is only one vocation and this comes through Baptism. The vocation of each of us is to be a disciple of Christ. This is then expressed and lived differently because of the different circumstances of our lives. Young people have so much to bring to other young people in today's world by helping them to come to know the goodness of following Christ. They also have great gifts to bring hope and freshness to their parents and other people in the parish. And older single people have gifts that are badly needed in today's world. They are often the people who look after a sick or elderly parent or sibling. Unfortunately, they can be taken for granted by the rest of the family and the care for a parent or sibling is left mostly to them. Good models for single people are Martha, her sister Mary and their brother Lazarus. Jesus was a frequent visitor to their home and often received hospitality at their table.
