Parish Prayer Day for Marriage and Family Life: On Tuesday next 20th November (early hours for some of us!) we pray for the 24 hours for Marriage & Family Life. Many people in our parish have committed themselves to a specific hour of prayer in such a way that the whole day and night are covered. Everyone is invited to join in this prayer, either by taking on an hour, or by including this intention in your own prayer during that day; November Theme: Remembering our beloved dead The Joy of Love: Pope Francis I can understand the anguish felt by those who have lost a much-loved person, a spouse with whom they have shared so much. Jesus himself was deeply moved and began to weep at the death of his friend (Lazarus). (254) Ordinarily the grieving process takes a fair amount of time. The entire process is filled with questions: about the reasons why a loved one had to die, about all the things that might have been done, about what a person experiences at the moment of death. With a sincere and patient process of prayer and interior liberation, peace returns. (255) It consoles us to know that those who die do not completely pass away, and faith assures us that the risen Lord will never abandon us..... Indeed, "our loved ones are not lost in the shades of nothingness, hope assures us that they are in the good strong hands of God". (256) Some Thoughts: November is a very special month for all of us especially in our families as we remember our loved ones who have died. And it is all about our families. The Catholic practice of remembering our dead is very special. The ways that our people care for their graves is a real sign of affection and also of faith in the resurrection. It can also be a sad time for people especially when death has been in the past year. It is so important to pray for and with one another at this time. Every family has people whom they love who have died. November is the month when we deliberately remember them and pray for them These memories can be painful because of the loss that is experienced or because of the difficulty of forgiving a loved one. These memories are essential because so much of what we are and have has come from these people whom we love and who love us.
