Parish Prayer Day for Marriage and Family Life: Next week, Wednesday the 20th February Parish Prayer Day for Marriage and Family Life. On the 20th of each month, our parish of Malin prays for the 24 hours for Marriage & Family Life. This is part of a Movement of Continuous Prayer for Marriage & Family Life as other parishes and groups take on the prayer for the other days of the month. To make this prayer continuous, many people in our parish have committed themselves to a specific hour of prayer in such a way that the whole day and night are covered. Everyone is invited to join in this prayer, either by taking on an hour, or by including this intention in your own prayer during that day. Just this week we celebrated St Valentine's Day so we ask you to pray especially for all married couples during this time.
