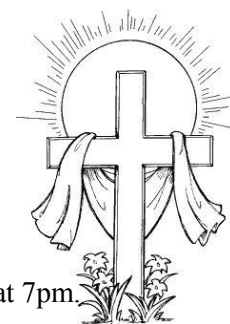

Reflection for Palm Sunday: Weep not for me but for yourselves

This week each year Christians are drawn to Jerusalem, in not in body, at least in mind. **They stand at the foot of the cross, beating their breasts, and staring with pity at Jesus of Nazareth. They listen with reverence as he prays for his killers: "Father forgive them for they know not what they do."** But when the week is over they return to their homes to resume their deep-rooted spites and the burden of things they can't forgive. Let us not then weep for Jesus. Let us weep for our own sins. Then maybe, like Jesus, we will be able to forgive others who sin against us.

Parish Prayer Day for Marriage and Family Life: Next Saturday is once again the 20th of the month, when our parish prays for the 24 hours for Marriage & Family Life. This is part of a Movement of Continuous Prayer for Marriage & Family Life as other parishes and groups take on the prayer for the other days of the month. To make this prayer continuous, many people in our parish have committed themselves to a specific hour of prayer in such a way that the whole day and night are covered. Everyone is invited to join in this prayer, either by taking on an hour, or by including this intention in their own prayer during that day; by including it in the prayers of the Masses celebrated on that day; by inviting the schools of the parish to involve the children and young people in praying for it; by asking any prayer groups that are meeting on that day to also include a prayer for it. All Families. The Joy of Love: Pope Francis Faithful to Christ's teaching we look to the reality of the family today in all its complexity, with both its lights and shadows. Anthropological and cultural changes in our time influence all aspects of life and call for an analytical and diversified approach. (78) Therefore, while clearly stating the Church's teaching, pastors are to avoid judgements that do not take into account the complexity of various situations, and they are to be attentive, by necessity, to how people experience and endure distress because of their condition.
