Fourth Sunday of Easter: Vocations Sunday

This is Good Shepherd Sunday, a day of special prayer for vocations to the work of service in the Church. There is the enduring command of Christ to his Church to go out and preach to all people. There is need for people of faith to respond to that command, people who are prepared to dedicate their lives to this work for the sake of the gospel.

The Vocation to Love: The deepest wound of all is that which affects the heart: the feeling that one has not been loved, that one is not precious to anyone. Many people today are wounded at heart. Each of us can do something to heal their wounds. We have hands that can make things, and minds that can understand things .But above all we have hearts that can give life. We are not sterile people. We can give life to people who are inwardly broken. We can show them that they are important, and so bring life to them.
Today, Good Shepherd Sunday, is also vocations Sunday. But all vocations are vocations to love.
