Parish Prayer Day for Marriage and Family Life: Next Wednesday 20th November, our parish prays for the 24 hours for Marriage & Family Life. Our theme this month is remembering our beloved dead. This is part of a Movement of Continuous Prayer for Marriage & Family Life as other parishes and groups take on the prayer for the other days of the month. The Joy of Love: Pope Francis: I can understand the anguish felt by those who have lost a much-loved person, a spouse with whom they have shared so much. Jesus himself was deeply moved and began to weep at the death of his friend (Lazarus). Ordinarily the grieving process takes a fair amount of time. The entire process is filled with questions: about the reasons why a loved one had to die, about all the things that might have been done, about what a person experiences at the moment of death. With a sincere and patient process of prayer and interior liberation, peace returns. It consoles us to know that those who die do not completely pass away, and faith assures us that the risen Lord will never abandon us..... Indeed, "our loved ones are not lost in the shades of nothingness, hope assures us that they are in the good strong hands of God". To make this prayer continuous, many people in our parish have committed themselves to a specific hour of prayer in such a way that the whole day and night are covered. Everyone is invited to join in this prayer, either by taking on an hour, or by including this intention in your own prayer during that day; by including it in the prayers of the Masses celebrated on that day; by inviting the schools of the parish to involve the children and young people in praying for it; by asking any prayer groups that are meeting on that day to also include a prayer for it.
