**Gospel Reflection: Zaccheus' Change of Heart:**

**It is only with the heart that we can repent rightly. Repenance must involve a change of heart.**

**Anything less won't produce a new being. It will be like decapitating weeds while leaving the roots intact.**

**But if we change our hearts, then we will change our lives too.**

**After his encounter with Jesus, Zaccheus' heart burst into life like a desert landscape after a rainfall.**

**Fear can't produce a conversion of heart: only an encounter with love can. Zaccheus' conversion was a conversion to goodness. All of us stand in daily need of such a conversion.**

**We need to move from a closed heart to an open heart, from a heart of stone to a heart of flesh.**
