**Parish day of Prayer for Marriage & Family Life: Couples getting married in the parish this year.** Pope Francis: We need to help young people to discover the beauty and dignity of marriage. They should be helped to perceive the attraction of a complete union that elevates and perfects the social dimension of existence, gives sexuality its deepest meaning, and benefits children by offering them the best context for their growth and development. (The Joy of Love No. 205). I encourage Christian communities to recognise the great benefits that they themselves receive from supporting engaged couples as they grow in love. (The Joy of Love No. 207) Some thoughts: · One the most important decisions a person will ever make is the decision to get married. It will change that person's life forever. · Along with this is the decision of whom to marry! · And then there is the decision of where to get married. Many people are making those decisions in our parish this coming year. They need our prayers. One of the purposes of this prayer is to highlight the importance of Marriage and Family Life for the Church and for society. A second purpose of it is to acknowledge the responsibility the parish has for the health and well-being of marriage and family life because of the Sacramental relationships that have been established between couples, families and the parish community.
