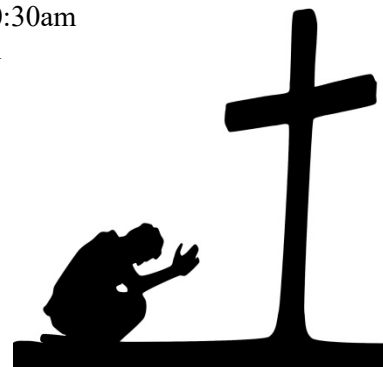

Parish Prayer Day for Marriage and Family Life. Theme: Thursday 20th June. Next Thursday, our parish of Malin prays for the 24 hours for Marriage & Family Life.
